In the past, a lack of understanding of some basic principles in international maritime law has resulted in mariners being jailed in foreign ports; in having vessels arrested and sold in judicially ordered proceedings; confiscation of cargoes; and being seized or fired upon by foreign warships on the high seas. Additionally, since World War II, the rise of piracy and maritime terrorism has impacted those engaged in the business of going to sea. This course will provide the substantive knowledge to avoid recurring ocean-based legal issues as well as useful direction for mariners, shore-base managers, and persons in leadership positions.
